# Community Development and Integration Program

Utilizing a user-friendly, storefront (drop-in) model, Abrigo Centre's Community Development and Integration Program (CDIP) assists more than 3,600 people a year. This program serves as a portal into all of Abrigo's services and addresses the needs of clients of all ages.

For decades Portuguese-speaking individuals, families and seniors have turned to Abrigo to access information and basic resources such as social assistance or pensions due to language barriers, computer illiteracy or isolation.

This program encourages individuals to develop and change according to their own needs and priorities, and at their own pace. Clients work to become better equipped to help themselves and move toward self-reliance.



### Be Actively Involved



Community development is about the active involvement of people in the issues that affect their lives. Newcomers from Portugal, Brazil and Portuguese speaking countries in Africa, although eager to integrate into society, often require support to access services and resources. Abrigo accommodates their needs and creates a welcoming and inclusive community that results in their successful adaptation and integration.

Abrigo's open intake system, funded with the assistance of the United Way Toronto & York Region, also allows any new client – either in person or by telephone – to speak to a counsellor for the first time between 1:00 p.m. and 3:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. Clients can ask our counsellors any question that they feel is important. Although the service is provided on a first-come, first-served basis, priority is given to women experiencing abuse.

### Key Program Components

#### Assessment, Information and Referral

We help connect individuals to essential services such as housing, employment insurance benefits and government benefits. Please see a list of other Abrigo services on the back cover.

#### Annual Income Tax Clinic

Our free income tax clinic completes over 1,200 personal tax returns for low-income families and individuals in our community each year. This long-standing service provided by Abrigo staff and volunteers is an invaluable part of our work in the months of March and April.

### Seniors Helping Seniors

An extraordinary team of volunteers, who are seniors, assists other seniors with form-filling services to access benefits and programs such as the Canada Pension Plan, Old Age Security, Ontario Drug Benefits and Canadian Passports.

#### **Volunteer Opportunities**

Under the leadership of our Volunteer Coordinator, each year more than 100 talented, dedicated and trained volunteers, including placement students, are interwoven throughout Abrigo and the CDIP program offering direct assistance to clients and staff members. Their tireless and enthusiastic efforts go a long way in allowing Abrigo to see a total of more than 6,400 clients each year.
